## Know the Bible Now (including Scripture references)

**MOSES AND THE PLAGUES**— [Exodus 7:14-10:29](#) | KtBN page 60

- Why does God wait and sometimes allow people to go through suffering? (If you have a hard time with this question, ask your pastor's opinion?)
- Exodus 6:6 says, "I am the Lord,...and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment." What was God's response to his people, even as they were suffering?

Prayer: *Lord, I don't always understand why things happen the way they do. But I trust in your mercy to see me through it. In Jesus name, Amen.*

**THE PASSOVER**— [Exodus 11:1-12:42](#) | KtBN page 62

- Why did God call this event "the Passover?"
- God told them to always remember the day of the "Passover." Why do you think it was important to remember and tell their children about it?

Prayer: *Lord, by Your great power and might you rescued the people of Israel from their bondage. Thank you for Jesus, who has released us from the bondage of sin, death and the power of the devil. Amen.*

**CROSSING THE RED SEA**— [Exodus 14:1-15:21](#) | KtBN page 64

- What did Moses tell the people, when they became afraid of Pharaoh's horses and armies coming after them?
- How do you think the Lord fights for you today?

Prayer: *Heavenly Father, protect and defend us with your powerful hand. Keep us strong in our trust in You, especially during times of trouble. Amen.*

**GOD PROVIDES MANNA AND QUAIL**— [Exodus 16](#) | KtBN page 66

- God gave them just enough food for one day at a time. What do you think it taught them?
- On the sixth day, they gather twice as much, so they could rest on the Sabbath. Why is it important to stop, rest and take time to workshop the Lord?

Prayer: *Lord, you provide for everything I need. Keep my eyes open and willing to serve those who may not have as much as I do. Amen.*

**GOD GIVES THE LAW**— [Exodus 19:1-20:17](#) | KtBN page 68

- What is the purpose of God's Law?
- None of us can keep God's Law perfectly. Talk about what Jesus has done to take care of our problem with sin. Think about one person you know who needs to hear this message and pray for an opportunity to share it with them.

Prayer: *Heavenly Father, the law shows us our sins and our need for you. Thank you for forgiveness of sins. It has changed our lives! Amen.*
