JESUS CALLS DISCIPLES — [John 1:35-51](#) & [Luke 5:1-11, 27-28](#) | KtBN page 234

- John called Jesus the "Lamb of God." Why was that an important title?
- Why do you think the disciples left everything behind to follow Jesus?

Prayer: *Dear Jesus, you called the disciples to follow, and they did. Keep our ears and our hearts attentive to Your Word and teach us to follow you. Amen.*

JESUS CHANGES WATER INTO WINE — [John 2:1-11](#) | KtBN page 236

- Why do you think Jesus did miracles? (Hint: See John 2:11)
- Why do you think Jesus produced so many gallons of the wine that was better than the good wine they served first at the wedding?

Prayer: *Lord God, Your miracles show us your power and reign in this world. We thank you for the miraculous gift of the Holy Spirit, working through Your Word to lead us to Faith in You. Amen.*

JESUS CLEARS THE TEMPLE — [John 2:13-22](#) | KtBN page 238

- Why was Jesus so upset with the money changers in the temple?
- Jesus talked about his death and resurrection after 3 days in the tomb. Why did Jesus talk about this now?

Prayer: *Lord, teach us to keep your Name Holy among us and Your Word as a powerful part of our daily lives. In Jesus Name, Amen.*

JESUS TEACHES NICODEMUS — [John 3:1-21](#) | KtBN page 240

- You hear some religious people talking about being "born again" with different definitions. In this passage, Jesus describes being "born again" by a very specific action. What is it?
- Despite the fact that we will never be able to be "good enough" to earn our way to heaven, what hope are we given in John 3:16?

Prayer: *Dear Jesus, you loved us so much that you gave your life to pay for our sins. Thank you for your mercy, which has changed our lives forever. Amen.*

JESUS AND THE SAMARITAN WOMAN — [John 4:1-42](#) | KtBN page 242

- When the Samaritan woman found out who Jesus was, what was her first reaction?
- Think about three people you know who need to know the forgiveness of sins offered to us in Jesus Christ. Identify them by name - pray for them - and ask God to give you an opportunity to invite them to church with you.

Prayer: *Lord, Jesus, the power of Your Word chases away temptation. Keep us strongly tied to Your Word and keep us safe in your presence. Amen.*
